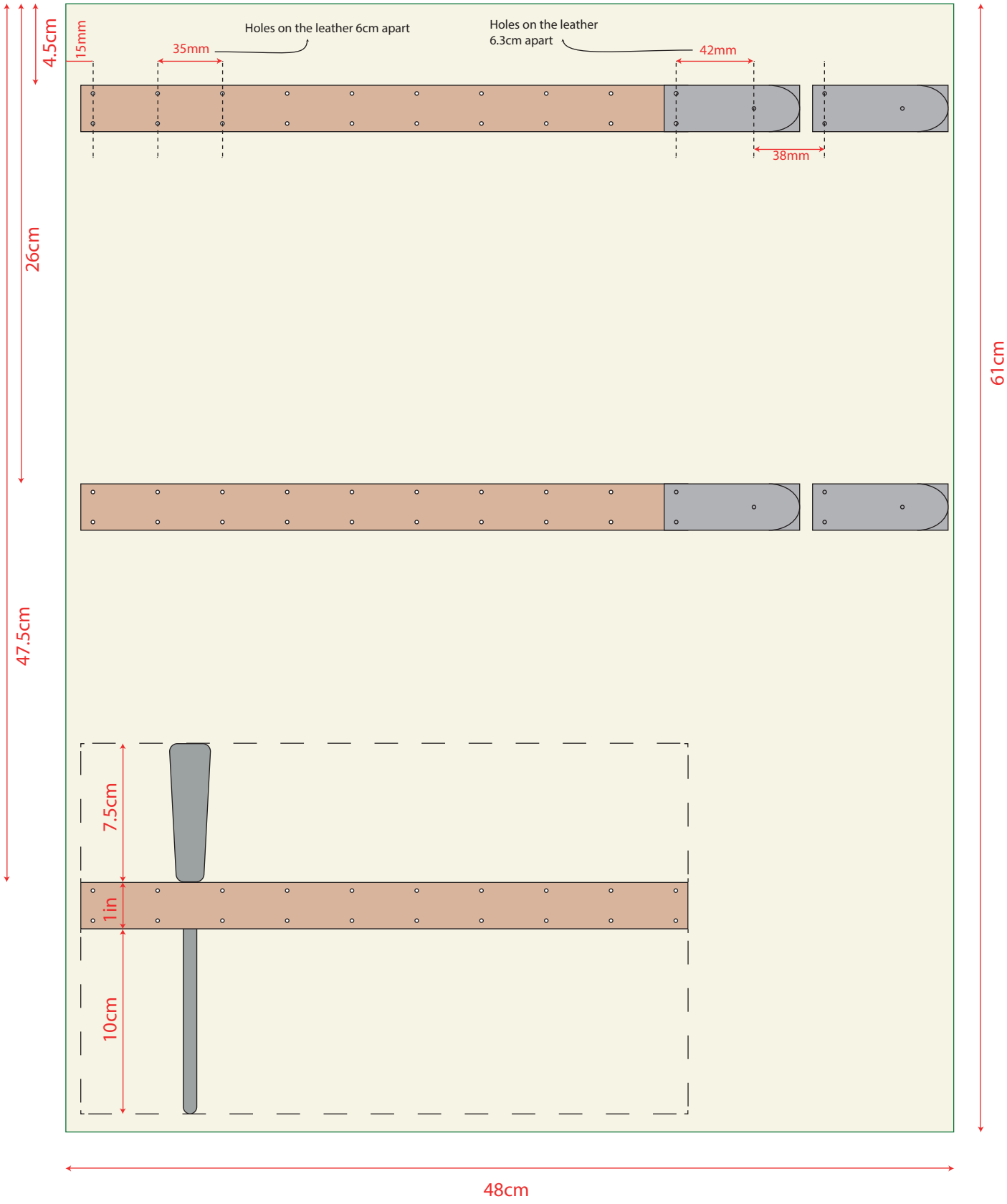
This layout allowed for 3 rows of tools with the 3rd being shorter to create space on the right to hang my wing dividers.

You can have any number of rows that you like of any length it's entirely up to you. If you maintain the vertical distance between the rows as shown that will give you plenty of space to get things in and out but again you can adjust the spacing if you prefer.

On the page after are the actual size pieces for the straps. You can cut enough 1" strap with a strap cutter and then simply lay the template over the top to help you accurately mark the holes.

Templates are also included for sticking to your wooden board as I did if you wish to pre-drill your holes. You can print as many template pieces as you need and then overlay them by holding them up to a window and taping them together.

Be sure to print this document **without scaling (100%)** and make sure the straps measure 1" wide on the paper so you know the spacing is accurate. The document is A4 in size.
